## $Work\ regulations\ of\ the\ factory\ of$ $mechanical\ organs-Loui\ Hooghuys-Place\ de\ la\ Station\ N^{\circ}.11$ Geerardsbergen

- **Art.1** The normal working hours have been determined as follows: 6 hours on Monday and 11 hours on the other days. No work shall be done on Sundays and legal holidays.
- **Art.2** In accordance with the season and for the ease of lighting, the working hours have been determined as follows:

On Monday from 9 in the morning till 4 o'clock in the afternoon. On the other days, the workmen shall start in the morning at 6, 6.30 or 7 o'clock and they can leave in the evening at 6.30, 7 or 7.30 o'clock, with a break of one hour, from 12 till 1 o'clock. Furthermore, the workmen can take the necessary time in the morning to eat, and in the afternoon they get a break of 15 minutes to eat. These two breaks will not be deducted from the wages, *i.e.*: the workmen get paid for 11 hours of work.

- **Art.3** In addition, the workmen have the right, in special cases, to start and stop as they like; they are only asked to inform the chief of this. cht den meester hiervan te verwittigen.
- **Art.4** The workmen normally get paid per working hour; only exceptionally they will be paid per day, when and as agreed. t.
- **Art.5** The wages are paid weekly on Saturday. ld.
- **Art.6** There will be no fines nor deductions from the wages; the workmen are only asked in the general interest of the work to treat the tools, mechanisms, ... shortly: to treat everything as if it was their own property, and to use everything as economically as possible.
- **Art.7** To avoid all injuries, it is strictly forbidden for the workmen to use other tools or mechanics than those which they normally use and know; neither should they put on belts when the machinery is operational. They are also asked to treat everything with care.

Approved after regular consultation of the workmen in accordance with article 7 of the law.
